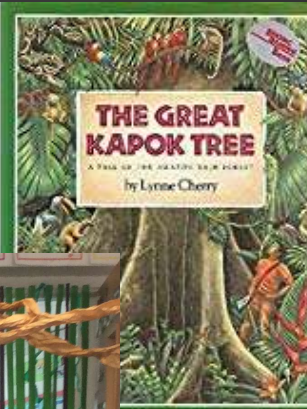
ON THE BEACH?

IN A RAINFOREST?

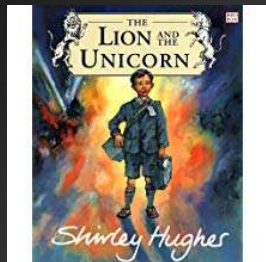

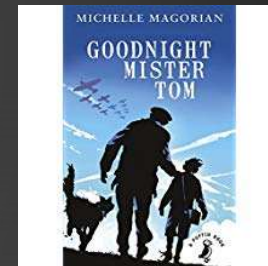


IN AN ANDERSON SHELTER?

I wonder who would wear a duffle coat and red wellies?

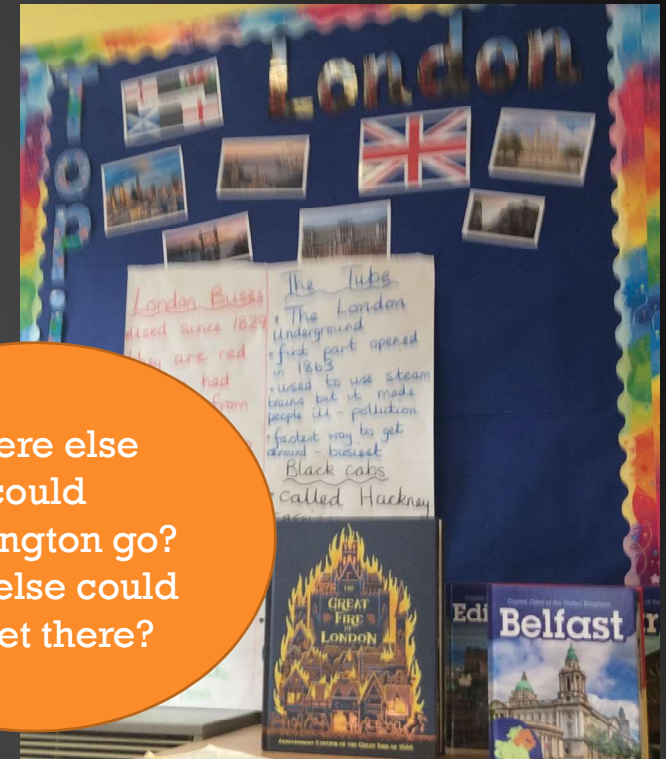


Hmm, funny looking suitcase-bit old-fashioned!

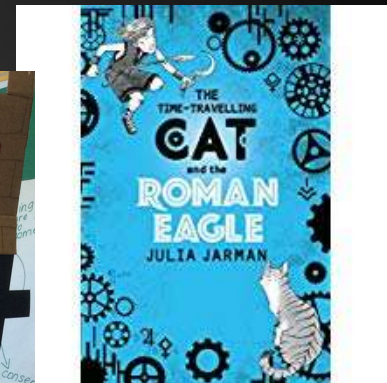
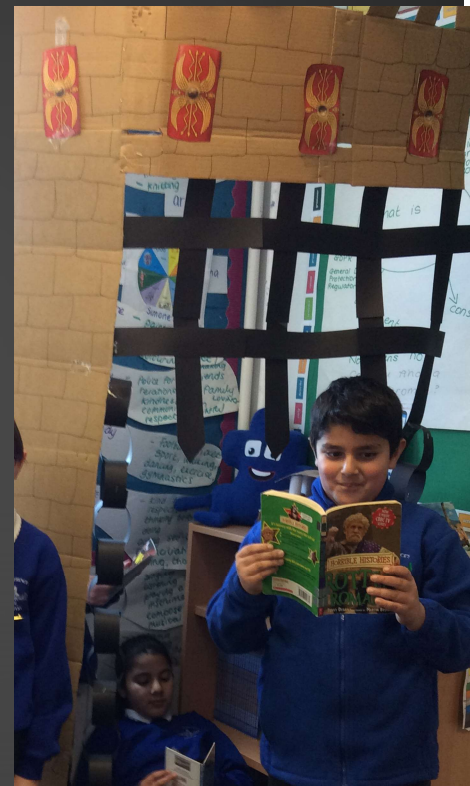
