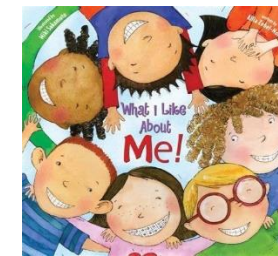

Curriculum Map- Autumn Term



Early Reading

In English this term, the children will be hearing stories about different families through high quality picture books. They will be sequencing events from the story 'Monkey Puzzle' and learning to identify key characters from Goldilocks. We will also make a strong start with our phonics programme - Unlocking Letters And Sounds.

Maths

In Maths this term, our Mastering Number programme will really help the children to understand how to count objects carefully, to count in order from zero and to find an amount. Wider Curriculum

Understanding The World

This term, the children will be describing people who are familiar to them and talking about places that they know well. The children will also explore the natural world around them.

Physical development

The children will explore our outdoor environment and develop their skills in climbing, running, jumping and balancing. They will also take part in P.E. We will also begin learning how to correctly hold a pencil.

Communication and Language

The children will develop their language skills through adult led activities and purposeful play, where they will learn to cooperate and take turns with their peers. They will also be encouraged to share their thoughts and ideas.

Home Learning

We would really like the children to continue reading their books with you at least 3 times a week. All children will also be bringing home their library book on Friday.

You may also be given a home learning challenge that links with our Wider Curriculum to explore our topics further.
